

WELLINGTON'S NEW LEISURE CENTRE KEEPS ITS COOL



Telford and Wrekin Council have installed a system of Celsius EcoCooling evaporative coolers at its new 'state of the art' leisure centre.

They have strict Carbon targets and the EcoCoolers help them reach those targets, the EcoCooling system uses far less power than a conventional air conditioning system, the

area is heated using a ground source heat pump and they also have a biomass boiler and solar water heating for the swimming pool, all proven low carbon technologies.

EcoCooling was chosen for its low carbon credentials and also because it constantly changes the air in the areas with filtered, cooled, fresh air, this overcomes the odour problems that many Gyms suffer from.

The Celsius system uses 80 tonnes less carbon than a comparable air conditioning system and it was 20% less expensive to install.
